

ECONOMIC FORUM IN KRYNICA



So important opinion-forming journals as *Le Monde* and *Le Soir* acclaimed the Economic Forum in Krynica as *Eastern Davos*. Krynica – the biggest Central European event, has become an important place on the political map of the world, the only one, where so well-represented East meets with the West.

Every year the Forum is attended by approx. 2 000 guests representing nearly 60 countries from Europe, America and Asia, including high-rank politicians, government-parliamentary delegations, experts, heads of central institutions, businessmen, economic and non-governmental organizations. The Krynica's Promenade – during the Forum – is the biggest salon in Europe. Debates of the Forum are reported by almost 400 journalists from the biggest Polish and world's media representing 150 titles.

The Forum's programme contains, inter alia, nearly 130 debates, divided into 11 topic groups:
